
### Features

### DOs and DON'Ts

### **DOs**

- The materials for the manikin are special compositions of soft resin.
- Please handle them with the utmost care at all times.
- Dry the model after use, otherwise it might cause mold.
- Store the training set at room temperature, away from heat, moisture and direct sunlight.

### DON'Ts

- Don't use the colored fluid, otherwise the manikin would be stained and it could not be cleaned off. Use the water.
- Never wipe the components with thinner or organic solvent.
- Don't mark on the components with pen or leave any printed materials in contact with their surface. Ink marks on the surface won't be removable.

# Preparation/Setting

### O Assembly of the oral care model

- 1. Remove the black knob in the back of the soft lower face by turning it counterclockwise, and put the face manikin on the stand.
- 2. Then the face manikin by screwing the back knob clockwise.









### Adjusting of the position

1. Loosen the black knob counter clockwise to adjust the horizontal angle and then fix it by tightening the knob.















Be careful not to turn the knob too tight.



When the manikin face does not maintain its designated sagittal angle, tighten the screw on the stand by a



## **Setting the Denture**

1. Put the upper and lower dentures over respective gums so that dents at the back of dentures fit to the gums. Press the dentures to set in place.
















\*Be careful not to tuck the tongue by the dentures.
