About the Simulator

Proven effective, the **Life/form**® Sigmoidoscopic Examination Simulator is an excellent teaching aid for training health care professionals in all aspects of the flexible sigmoidoscopic examination. Originally produced exclusively for ACMI, this simulator has been used for physician training nationwide.

General Instructions for Use

Treat this simulator as if it were an actual patient. Excessive pressure, failure to properly lubricate, etc., can cause damage. The prolonged life and use of this simulator depends on proper handling.

This simulator offers all the challenges encountered with real patients; the value of examining the entire length of the large intestine has been established, and this unit provides all the practice necessary for confident transferal of applied techniques.

The first step in using this unit is to lubricate it, but don't use just any lubricant; the recommended lubricant is water. Use the large syringe supplied and squeeze a generous supply into the simulator.

Once all instrumentation has been lubricated, proceed as per the instructor's advice. Proper instruction and practice will develop the necessary hand/eye coordination to allow passage of the sigmoidoscope through the entire length of the intestine.

As the scope follows the contours of the large intestine, the student must negotiate the sigmoid colon, splenic fixture, and hepatic flexure; thereafter, viewing of the ascending colon and cecum is possible.

As the scope is withdrawn, the student can identify benign sessile, pedunculated, and hyperplastic polyps, as well as cancerous lesions. These are repeated through the intestine for a total of 12 pathological conditions to diagnose. All manipulative and photographic techniques can also be practiced.

Care of the Simulator

Normal surface soil can be removed with mild soap and lukewarm water. Use Nasco Cleaner (LF09919U) to remove stubborn stains from the simulator. Simply spray soiled area and wipe clean with a soft cloth or paper towel.

- DO NOT mark on the simulator in any way.
- DO NOT allow any newsprint to come into contact with the simulator. Ink of any type will cause indelible stains.
- DO NOT use a substitute lubricant; water works best.
